

Borough of Poole is planning improvements to Shore Road promenade to include:




Consultation Day - Thursday 14 June Shore Road Promenade

Frequently Asked Questions

Why are these improvements needed?

Shore Road is a major gateway for people visiting Poole's beaches. However the buildings are outdated and the public space is tired, with failing infrastructure and worn ground conditions. We'd like to create a space that is more attractive, vibrant and provides a warm welcome.

How much will it cost?

Of the £1.2million awarded from the Coastal Community Fund for improvements along Poole's Seafront, this scheme is expected to cost up to £650,000.

How do I share my views?
